ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME RULES

ELIGIBILITY

St. Peter's International School offers two types of academic scholarships:

- Two scholarships for entry into Ensino Secundário (Portuguese Curricula) are open to students currently in Grade 9 of the Portuguese State Education System.
- Two scholarships for entry into the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) are open to students in Grade 10 in the Portuguese State Education System, Grade 10 in International Schools, or Year 11 in the United Kingdom system (see conversion chart at the end of the document).

PROGRAMME ENTRY

Successful scholarship applicants for Ensino Secundário will join St. Peter's in Grade 10.

Successful scholarship applicants for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) will join St. Peter's in Grade 11 (IBDP year 1).

AWARD CRITERIA

Scholarships will be awarded based on academic merit and potential, with particular emphasis on the student's academic achievements, abilities, and predicted outcomes.

For entry into our Ensino Secundário, students will be requested to sit assessments in:

- Portuguese
- Mathematics
- English

- BPR - Bateria de Provas de Raciocínio

For entry into our IBDP, student's will be required to sit :

- CAT4 (Cognitive Abilities Test)
- English
- Mathematics
- A Language

FEE REDUCTION

Scholarships will offer a fee reduction ranging from 50% to 100%, with specific fee reduction to be based on family means.

PROGRAMME COMMITMENT

Scholarship recipients for Ensino Secundário are required to complete their education at St. Peter's, including Grade 12. The scholarship remains valid for the entire duration of their Secundário education (three years), contingent upon maintaining the required academic performance.

Scholarship recipients for the IBDP are required to complete the programme at St. Peter's. The scholarship remains valid for the entire duration of the IBDP (two years), contingent upon maintaining the required academic performance.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF FEE REDUCTION

The scholarship fee reduction does not cover additional costs, including overnight trips, extracurricular activities, lunch, transport, or fees associated with examinations.

Scholarship recipients are not eligible to participate in any Inspired exchange programmes during the duration of their scholarship.

The scholarship is non-transferable and cannot be applied to siblings or other family members.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form along with the required supporting documents, which include:

- Two years of school reports
- Any awards achieved in the last two years
- Two reference letters from academic settings

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection committee will review all applications and conduct interviews with shortlisted candidates. The committee's decision is final and not subject to appeal.

ONGOING PERFORMANCE AND REVIEW

Scholarship recipients must maintain a high academic standard throughout their studies at St. Peter's (Secundário average score 18 points or higher; IBDP average 38 points or higher).

The scholarship will be reviewed annually based on academic performance, and failure to meet the required standards may result in a reduction or withdrawal of the scholarship.

BEHAVIOURAL EXPECTATIONS

Scholarship recipients are expected to uphold the values and behavioural standards of St. Peter's International School. Any disciplinary issues may result in the revocation of the scholarship.

HEALTH AND SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Scholarship students must meet all health and safety requirements set by the school, including submitting medical records and undergoing health assessments if required.

COMMUNICATION OF RESULTS

Applicants will be notified of the scholarship results by **9th May**.

TERMINATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship may be terminated if the recipient voluntarily withdraws from the school or is dismissed due to academic or behavioural issues. In such cases, any remaining fees will be due, and no further fee reductions will apply.
